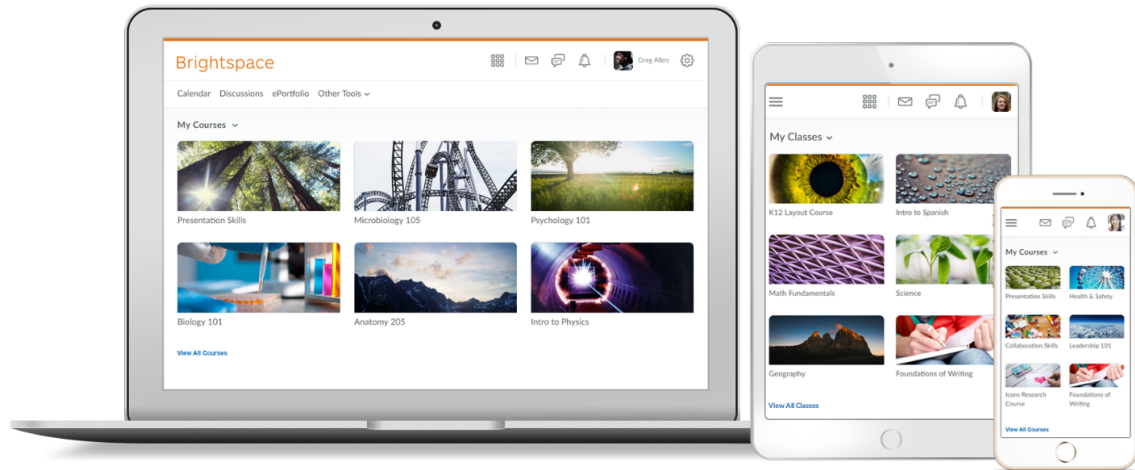


D2L, the company who makes Avenue to Learn, has unveiled their new design ethos and framework for Avenue to Learn called Daylight. This new framework allows Avenue to Learn to behave in a responsive manner to whichever device (mobile phone, tablet, laptop or desktop) is viewing the page. This is a beneficial development as many of you access Avenue to Learn not only through laptops, but mobile devices as well. Some improvements include simplified navigation, wider page layout, design consistency between tools and a new My Courses widget.



There will be changes in the font, layout and overall design “feel” of courses after we upgrade to Daylight. We aim to turn Daylight on for Avenue to Learn on the morning of August 7th, 2017 and are letting you know about this well in advance of that change.
